Journalist visas to enter Cuba must be authorized by the International Press Center of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Cuba. THIS AUTHORIZATION PROCEDURE TAKES A MINIMUM OF THREE WEEKS.

Application procedure:

- Fill out this application form and send it to the Cuban Press Office of the Cuban Embassy. Attach a photocopy of the main page of your passport.
- Enclose a cheque or postal order for **£22.00** payable to HAVIN BANK. This is to cover consular services in connection with your visa application.
- Submit a written version of your journalistic project.
- Submit a sponsor letter from your employer.
- Submit a list of the photographic/filming equipment you intend to carry.
- You may be contacted by the Embassy's Press Secretary for clarification on your journalistic project.
- When the visa is authorized, submit your passport plus 2 passport-size photographs and send **£47.00** (postal order payable to HAVIN BANK to cover the cost of the visa. If you apply by post, enclose a self-addressed envelope for the return of your documents. *(We strongly recommend that you send your documents by Special Delivery and enclose a pre-paid Special Delivery SAE for the return of your documents)*

Once in Cuba you must report to the **International Press Center** for accreditation. Take 2 photographs and \$60.00 CUC

All consular services carried out by post or courier; require an additional non-in person fee of £22.00 per person
