VALIDATION OF DOCUMENTS FOR USE IN CUBA MAIN INFORMATION OF PAYMENT METHODS

For legal purposes in Cuba, documents issued in the UK must be legalized by the Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) and legalized and certified by the Cuban Consulate. Only original documents properly validated are acceptable. Please, be aware that documents not issued in the UK have to be legalized by the proper authorities of the country and then authenticated by the Cuban Consulate/Embassy in the country where they have been issued.

The fee for legalization and certification of a document at the Cuban Consulate is £95.00 (per document).

If the original document is in English it must be accompanied by a Spanish translation. (See below). This translation needs to be notarized, legalized by the FCO, and finally legalized and certified by the Cuban Consulate. It will be treated as an original document.

Then the consular fee will be £95 document in English + £95 document in Spanish. The Cuban Consulate cannot authenticate documents without the FCO apostille.

All consular services carried out by post, courier or on behalf of another person require an additional non-in person fee of £22.00 per person

Postal orders and banker's drafts payable to **HAVIN BANK** are accepted. **CASH AND PERSONAL CHEQUES ARE NOT ACCEPTED.**

Please, enclose a pre-paid self addressed envelope for the return of your documents as the non in person fee does not cover the postage costs of their return. We recommend the use of Recorded Mail or Special Delivery. The consular office is not responsible for any lost or damage of the documents.

The Cuban Consulate provides translation services of documents.

English – Spanish: £17.00 per page
Spanish – English: £26.00 per page

Translations made in the Cuban Consulate do not require FCO legalization. Processing time and delivery date of translated documents should be agreed

with the Consulate before application.

Please bear in mind that legalized documents are only valid for six months from the date of issue.
